Welcome Ecyc Overview & Expectations

Dear 2024-2025 East Carolina Youth Council,

Welcome! Whether this is your first year serving or you are returning, the Diocese of East Carolina is glad to have each of you on board. Hopefully most of your questions will be answered or your memories jogged about the council's expectations and commitments.

As the application stated, and as returning members know, serving on the ECYC is a commitment. A choice you made when you submitted your application. All of us have other commitments outside of ECYC. However, the event and meeting schedule are communicated in advance to help you plan. Keep in mind that our current meeting schedule is slim, just four in person meetings and two Zoom meetings per year. As a general rule of thumb, you should not plan to miss a meeting. You never know when a true emergency might pop up. In addition, when you aren't with us, we miss you! We miss your opinion, your ideas, and your insights. Whether we are meeting in person or online, please note that arriving late or leaving early is challenging to the community during a meeting, therefore it should be avoided. Making a commitment to being a leader is not a small undertaking, and it is part of an ECYC member's responsibility in supporting Youth Ministry in East Carolina.

Your leadership on the ECYC is not just about showing up to council meetings and youth events on the diocesan level. It requires communication on your part. Communication with me, the other adults and council members is critical the success of the ECYC.

Your leadership also includes active participation in your own parish. Your parish has helped equip you for this ministry and recommended you to serve on the ECYC. Active participation in your own congregations means at minimum, regular attendance at worship. It should include active participation in a ministry or program you enjoy. If you are having trouble identifying one, let's have a conversation.

Please be mindful of your presence on Social Media. As a member of the ECYC and leader of this Christian Community it is very important to think before you post, comment, like, or share. What may be funny or not offensive to you, may be perceived very differently by others.

Emergencies happen. They are handled on a case by case basis. These include eminently contagious illness, family deaths, or the like. Sometimes a teacher will decide an academically required event will take place on the same day as a youth event. Academically required means that you would be receiving a grade and missing it would negatively impact your overall grade. ACT and SAT testing and the like should be scheduled around ECYC activities and events. Again, if you cannot be with the group or at an event, we miss your opinions, ideas, and insights. School trips and other conflicts that do not involve a grade are not exceptions. Documentation from your teacher or school may be asked for, if needed. Academic excuses are typically not granted on a repeated basis.

By the same token, some ECYC leadership opportunities will take you out of school. While this is kept to a minimum, sometimes it is unavoidable. In all cases, you may request letter on Diocesan letterhead that explains your absence.

Please be sure that you are checking your email. While I do send "remind" texts, checking email for updates is your responsibility. I cannot relay everything via text. You are the ECYC member, therefore it is not the responsibility of your parent or guardian to respond for you. They are on the email list for informational purposes.

The returning members are excited to welcome our new members aboard. I cannot wait to see how God works through this group in the coming year!

- · Be sure to include travel time to and from meetings/events in your planning.
- Be sure to verify internet connectivity prior to any online meeting or gathering and that you have a quiet place to participate in the meeting.
- ECYC meetings are business meetings. It is fun to see friends, but don't forget there is work to do.
- Serving on the ECYC is more than event planning.
- Your role may require you to speak to adult lay leaders and clergy across the diocese.
- Remember you not only represent yourself, you also represent your parish and deanery. How you present yourself through/on social media, texting, and in person represents the ECYC.
- You will be responsible for a lot of tasks. These may or MAY NOT be glamorous. A lot of ECYC work is behind the scenes, not up front. ECYC members have work to do in between meetings as well.


Diocesan Convention


Convention is usually a requirement for all ECYC members. For this term it will be an online Budget Convention only and therefor is not required.

ECYC Members are often offered opportunities to participate in events in the broader Episcopal Church.

The Episcopal Youth Event (EYE) is the most well known and has happened triennially in the past. The next EYE is scheduled for 2026.

Province IV

The Episcopal Church is comprised of 9, mostly, regional provinces. The Diocese of East Carolina is part of Province IV, which is the largest province containing 20 dioceses across the southeastern United States.

There are often events & opportunities available to some or all ECYC Members on the Provincial level. This includes the Province IV Youth Leadership & Network gathering in December as well as Provincial Youth Events that typically take place in the summer.
